ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

1. The Trustees acknowledged a Thank You card from Mr. & Mrs. Slaven. The card thanked the Trustees for doing a great job providing the Township with a great road crew.
2. The Trustees acknowledged that the Winter Salt Contract was submitted.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

ZONING REPORT

Mr. Bey and Mr. Phillip informed us of the following:

2. We would still like to look into getting a new sign for in front of the Town Hall.
3. There have been some complaints that we do not have a leaf dump open year around.
4. Complaints have come in about loud noise. Mr. Bey stated that we cannot get involved in Civil Matters, so we cannot do anything about the noise
5. The Health Department sent 1526 Trares a Notice of Violation letter, stating that they had a significate amount of solid waste on the property. It looks like they have started to clean it up
6. They would like mowing letters to 2249 Waterloo Rd, 1526 Trares Rd.
7. The BZA Hearing for 1449 Summerset was approved.
8. There is no information to report on 1560 Carriage House.

VETERAN CASES

ROAD REPORT

Mr. Eldreth and Mr. McBroom informed us of the following:

1. They put in a crossover on Bolender Rd.
2. They have been crack sealing some of the roads.

5. We have been mowing the cemeteries.
6. There are trees on May and Trares Rd. that are on the phone lines. We are not allowed to remove these trees since they are on the lines.
7. There is a water problem on the corner of Saxe and Palm that we need to figure out how to solve.
8. Clean up day was none stop. Mr. Eldreth thanked the County for providing this service.
